

## Frequently asked Questions:

**Is our first planning meeting free?** Yes.

Your **first** sit down planning meeting is free. From then, we can correspond by E-mail and phone when needed. Additional sit down meetings will be \$30.00 per hour.

**Can I have more guests than are listed on the packages?** Yes.

We can customize any package to fit your needs.

**Can we have a payment plan?** Yes.

We can work up a payment plan that fits.

**When can my guests arrive?** Your guests may start arriving as soon as gate opens.

They will need to go to the **Will Call Window**. There, the lady at the will call window will check off their name on the guest list and hand them their ticket. Then it's on to faire for them.

**When should the Bride & Groom /Wedding Party arrive at faire?**

At least **1 hour** before ceremony time.

**Do I bring my gown to faire and get dressed there?** No.

You and your wedding party should be as fully prepared as possible. Space is limited.

**Can I bring in a photographer(s)?** Yes. **Can I bring my own officiate?** Yes.

They will need to be included on your guest list.

**Can I bring my own wedding cake or food?** Yes.

We will need to make arrangements to pick them up at the front gate with a cart. With your own food, **you are responsible** for keeping it safe for consumption. (Hot, Cold, and Reheating)

**Can I bring in a DJ?** No.

The wedding tent is in the middle of the renaissance fair and a DJ would be out of place. You may wish to hire a period group or harpist from outside of faire, to entertain exclusively for your wedding reception. Some times it is possible to hire one of the acts performing at faire, but their availability is limited because of show schedules/ times.

**Can I have a rehearsal?** Yes.

Many times the Officiate will be on site attending to other interests at faire. But if they need to make a special trip to site for your rehearsal, an **extra fee** will be charged.

**When do we bring our extras in?**

Rehearsal night or that 1 hour before ceremony is a good time to bring your Favors, Unity candle, Toast glasses, **Marriage License**, Guest book, Cake knife, Center pieces, Seating chart/cards, cup cakes & tree etc...

We can meet you with our garden cart.

Setting up of your favors, center pieces and etc (not included in your wedding package) falls to your attendants, a family member, or yourself. So remember to set aside enough time. Tables would be set up and ready for Gate opening. We also can negotiate a fee for set up, of the outside items.

**What happens if it rains?**

The ceremony can/may move into the decorated reception tent.

**Where do I get our marriage license?**

You two will need to get to the town hall in the town where you will be getting married.
